



Application/ Renewal for Annual Parking Pass – (for motor cars and motorcycles only)

The Malvern Hills Trust issue an Annual Parking Pass for those who do not live within the Levy paying area which costs **£41.00** and runs for 12 months from the date of purchase. A second car registration number at the same address can be added for an additional cost of **£16.00**. A charge of **£1.00** applies on top of the total cost of passes, for applications where no **stamped addressed envelope** is included.

Annual Passes can be purchased by bacs, card or cheque using one of the following options:

By Post: complete this application form and post it with your preferred payment by cheque or bacs and a **stamped addressed envelope** or by adding an additional £1.00 to your payment to cover the cost of postage.

By Email: email your completed application form to parking@malvern hills.org.uk and ensure your bacs payment includes an additional £1.00 to cover the cost of postage and administration.

By Phone: please call 01684 892002 between 9.30am and 3.30pm, Monday to Friday, we will take your details and card payment over the phone and post your pass to you.

Cheques should be made payable to **Malvern Hills Trust** and posted to **Manor House, Grange Road, Malvern, WR14 3EY**. For BACs payments, please note this payment method on the form and use the following bank details: **Sort Code 30-95-41 Account No 01728306**, using your surname and car registration number as the reference *e.g. (SMITH AA11AAA)*.
